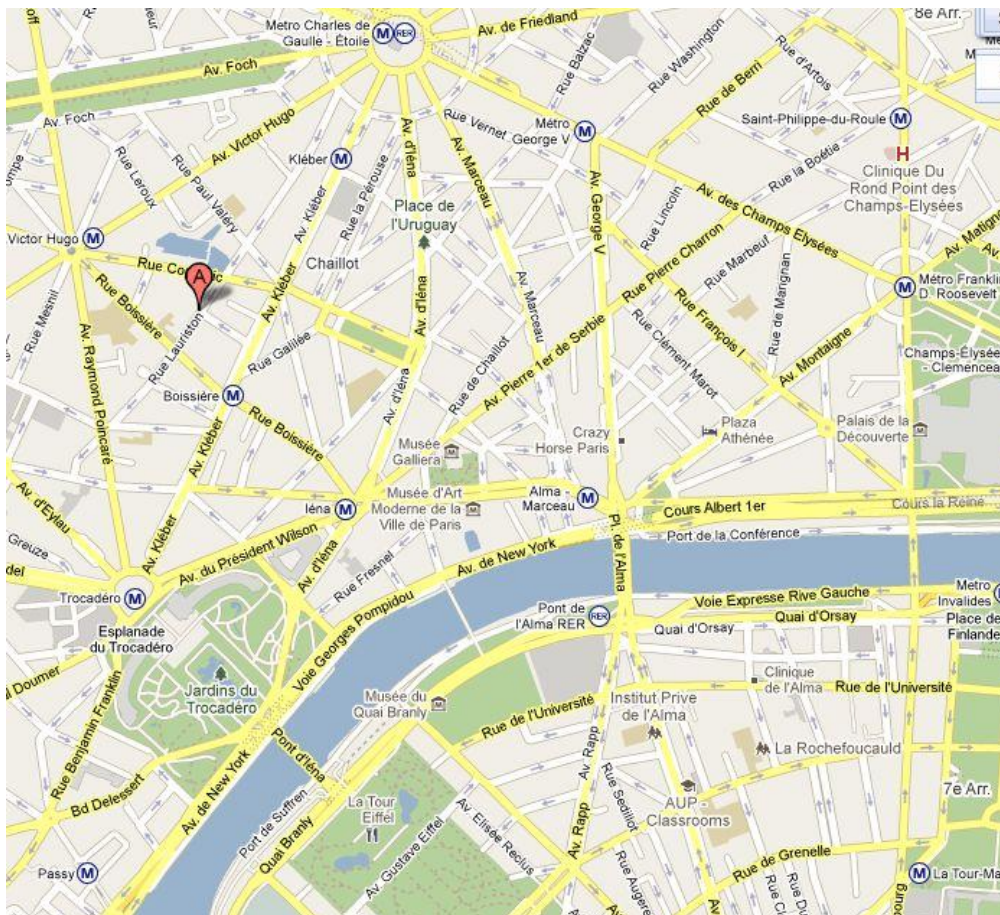
Due to time limitations each delegate may submit at most one talk. Please note that it is NOT necessary to submit a presentation in order to attend the meeting.
